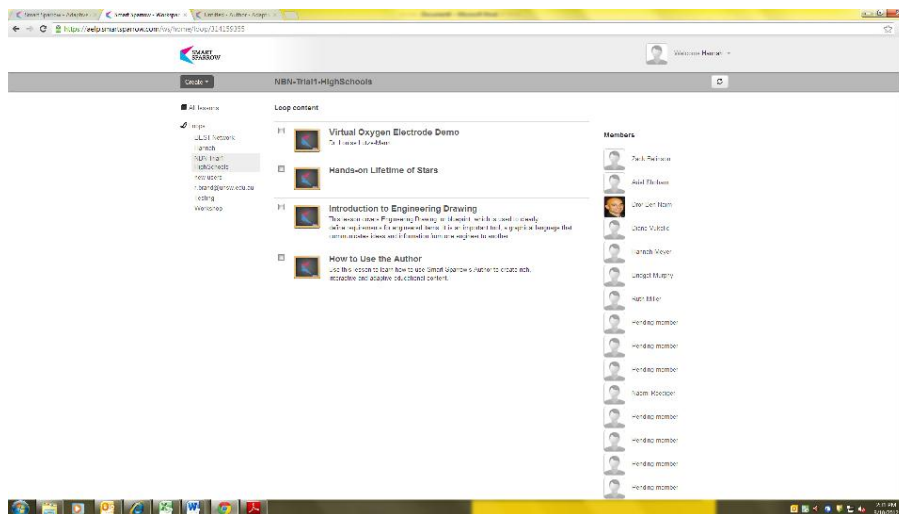


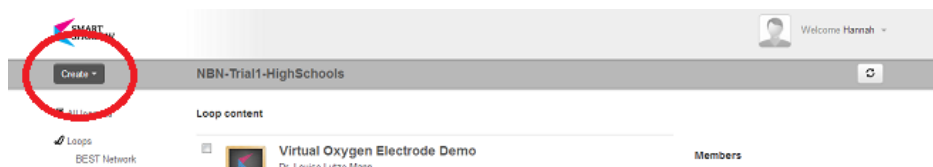
AeLP Quick Guide

Smart Sparrow's Adaptive eLearning Platform (AeLP) is an eLearning tool that enables educators to build and interactive and adaptive tutorials. Using the AeLP, educators can create online tutorials which adapt to the students' answers with customised feedback and pathways through the tutorial. This quick guide will give you a short tour through the AeLP.

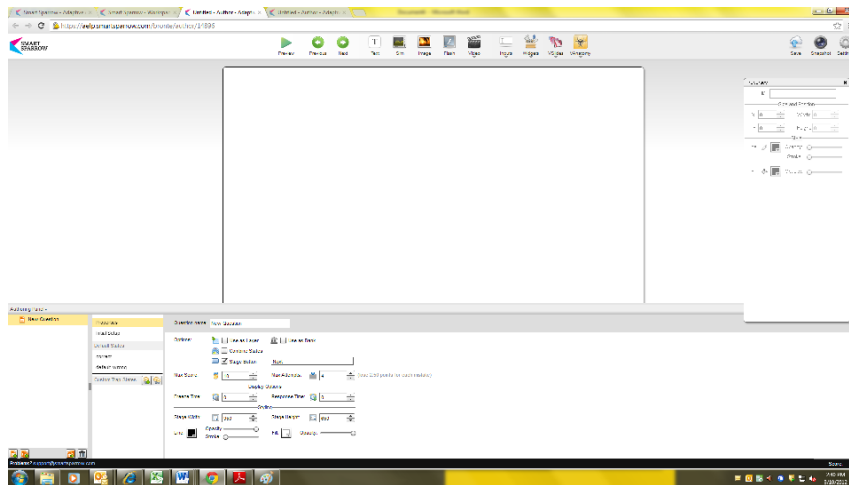
1. **Log in** through the Smart Sparrow website to arrive at your individual workspace. This workspace will act as your AeLP home page. From here you can see a list of all the tutorials you have built, create new tutorials, share or 'loop' your tutorials to your colleagues or view detailed analytics of your students' performance in your tutorials.



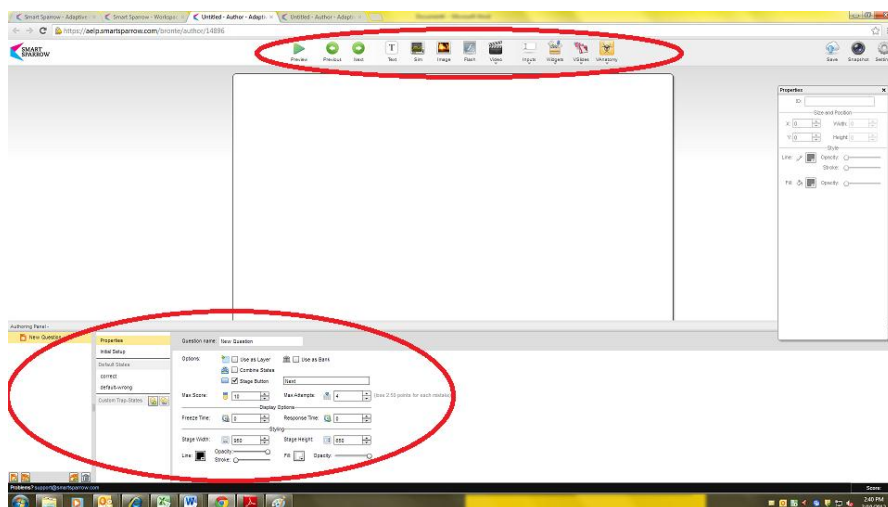
2. To **create a new tutorial**, click on the 'Create' button and select 'Lesson'.



3. A new tutorial will automatically open. Enter the name and lesson details when prompted and press ok. **The stage area** (below) is where you will begin building your tutorial.

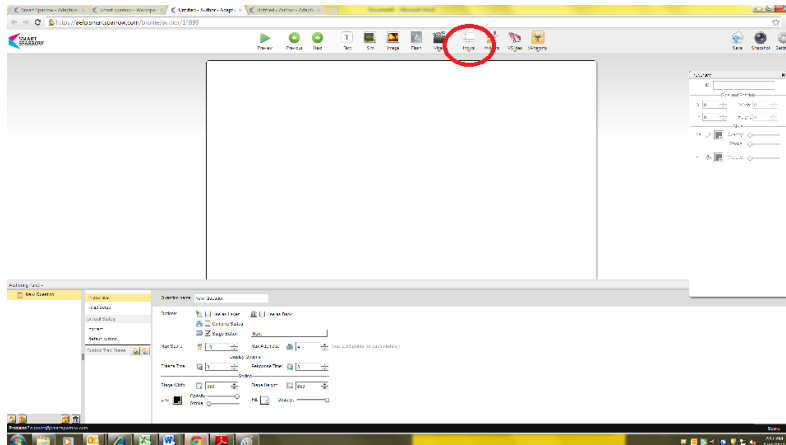


4. Around the stage area are the **Authoring Tools**. Using the Authoring tools you can create new questions, add images and customise adaptive feedback and pathways.

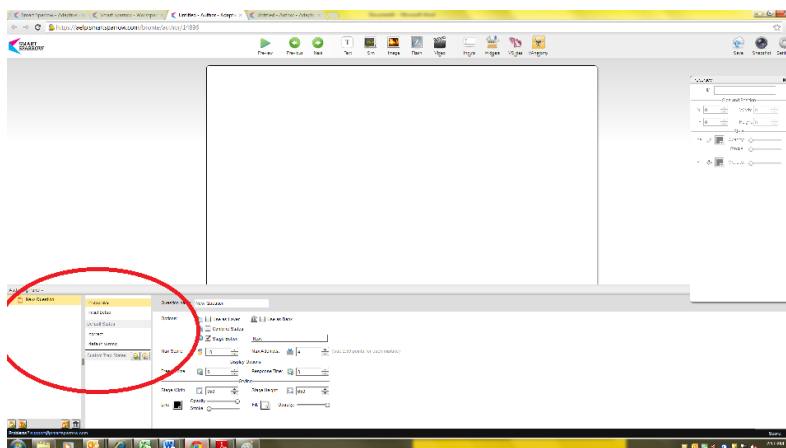


5. The Authoring Tools allow a vast number of options for creating adaptive and interactive elements in your tutorial. Here we will only list a couple of the most important tools, but feel free to explore them!

Inputs: The Input tool offers a range of question templates you can add to the stage area, including multiple choice questions, dropdown box, and single and multi-line answers. Click the Input button and select the question template you would like to use to enter the Input onto your stage area.



Default and Custom Trap States: To edit the answer options and build adaptive feedback and pathways around an Input, you need to edit the Default and Custom Trap-States. The default-states are Correct and Default-Wrong. Below these states are the Custom-Trap-States. You can add as many Custom Trap-States as you like. Use the 'Add Condition' and 'Display Feedback' buttons to edit both the Default and Custom Trap-States.



Text: Click the text button to add a textbox to the stage area. Click once on the text box to activate the properties panel, which will appear on the right of the screen. The properties panel has all the tools you need to change the size of your text box and format your text. Click the text box twice to begin typing in your textbox.

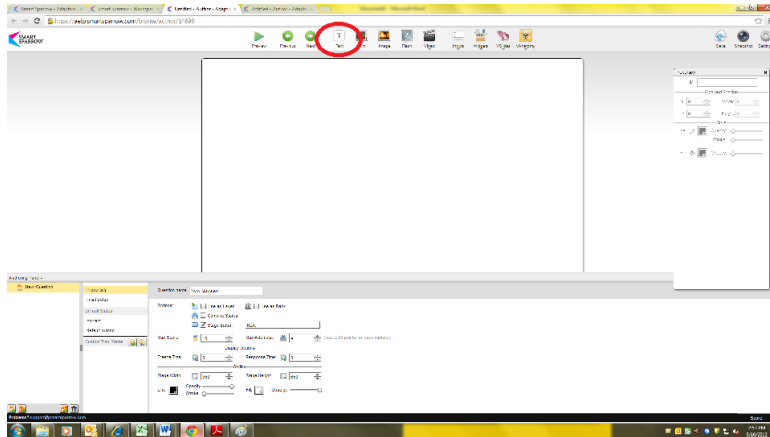
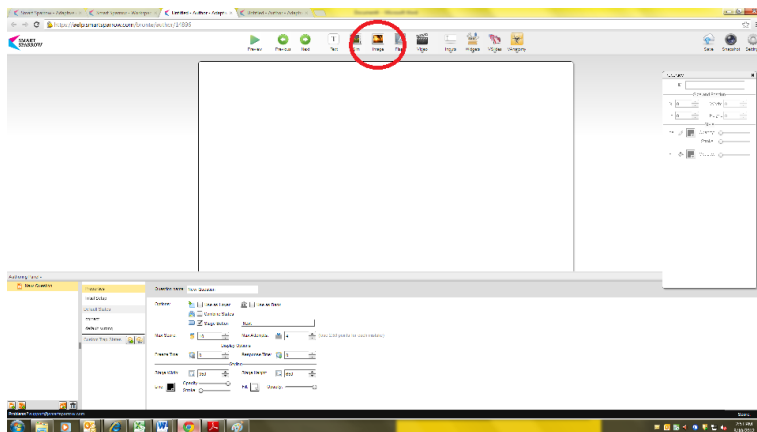
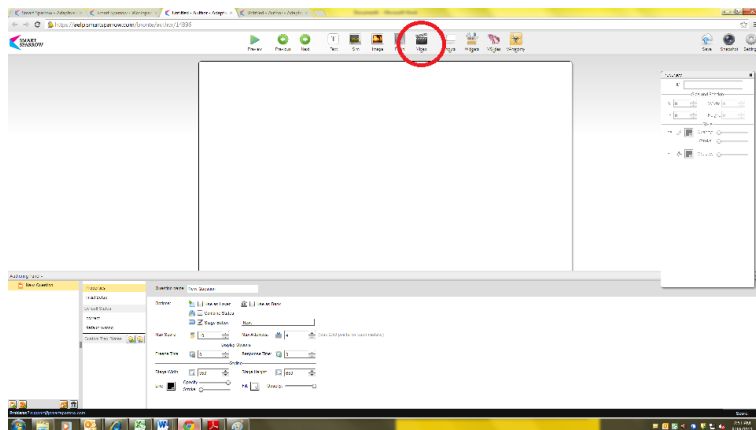


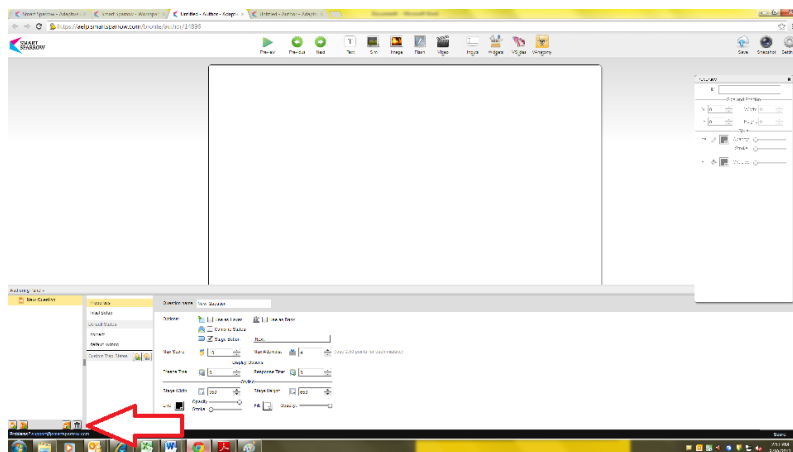
Image: Click image to open the image library box and add an image from your image library. Simply double click on the image you wish to add. To upload a new image to the library, click the 'Add New' button, at the top of the image library box.



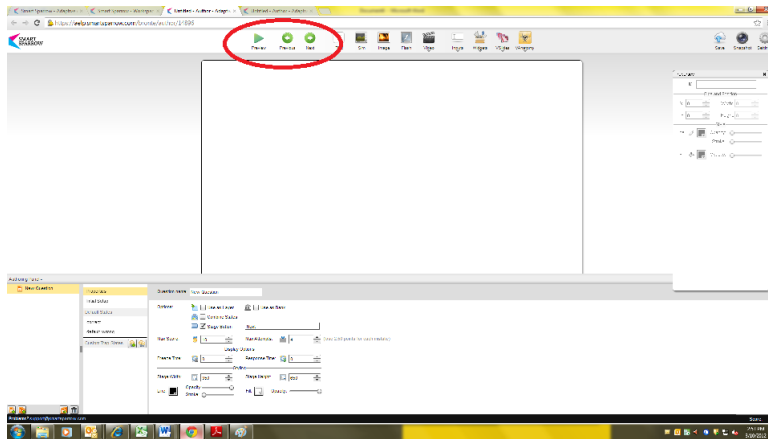
Video: The video tool allows you to import a YouTube video to the stage area. Click the button and select 'YouTube' from the dropdown bar. This will open an outline of a YouTube video on the stage area. Click once on this outline to open the editing options. A small blue box will appear on the top right hand corner of the YouTube video outline. Click this box to open the editing settings. Copy the URL of the YouTube video you wish to use into the box labelled 'Video ID', then press ok to input the video to the stage area.



Add a question: To add a question select the button on the bottom far left corner of the Authoring Panel. A new, blank stage area will appear, ready for you to build your next question. You can also add sub-questions, duplicate a question and delete a question with the buttons in the same row.



Preview: The preview button allows you to view and trial your tutorial as if you are a student completing the lesson. The **Previous** and **Next** buttons allow you to move through your tutorial, while you are in Preview mode.
